Would you like to read a fascinating book about time travel, **Deja**, by Michael Gunter, and meet to discuss?

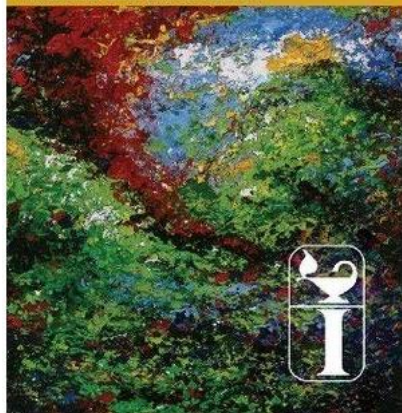
