DAY OF THE DEAD

Explore Its Mysteries with Andrew and Fabiola Chesnut

Following Jazz Vespers, Sunday, October 31st at 6 PM

Many of us became aware of the wondrous Mexican Day of the Dead tradition through the enchanting film *Coco*. Now you can learn more about it from two friends of the Kirk who are intimately acquainted with this unique celebration. Andrew Chesnut, Latin American historian, and Professor of Religious Studies at VCU, is the author of numerous books on Latin American religions. Fabiola Lopez-Chesnut, who is a Spanish teacher and Head of the Language and Arts Department at Huguenot High School, grew up in Morelia, Michoacan, Mexico where the mountains provide winter haven for the Monarch butterflies who have a special connection to Day of the Dead observances. So, come, find out what that magical connection is and what DOD has to do with All Saints Day, All Souls Day, and our American Halloween.
