This program is FREE and open to everyone.

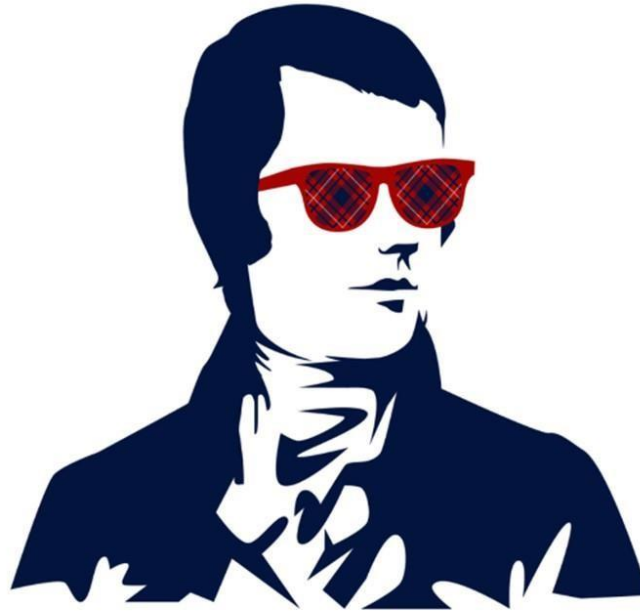
We will explore books, nature, and emotional growth with open-ended activities.
