KIRK INLOW FUND

The Kirk Inlow Fund annual income goes to local organizations serving RVA's neediest.

Over 10 years, the Fund donated nearly \$130,000 in grants. In 2025, the Fund distributed \$19,000 to ACTS and CARITAS. The Fund is managed by the Community Foundation of Richmond.


YOUTH
